Certified from Oak to Acacia



Grow-your-own specialist, Haxnicks is now using FSC-certified acacia for the timber frames of their best-selling Hardwood Plant House and Cold Frame. The high quality acacia timber has much to recommend it. It is harder and slightly denser than oak, with a finer grain, and it naturally absorbs less water; all qualities which make it ideal for outdoor use and better suited for the timber frame construction.

The design of the Plant House and Cold Frame has been improved at the same time, with the addition of drainage holes along the front rail of the sloping lids, and pre-fixed door and lid hinges to make self-assembly even easier.

They are ideal for over-wintering plants and hardwood cuttings, or for bringing-on and hardening-off seedlings before planting out. The acacia frames are glazed with shatter-proof, twin-walled polycarbonate which let in plenty of light and provides the best possible protection from the cold. Useful if you don't have a greenhouse, or simply need some more greenhouse space.

The Plant House (110cm high x 76cm wide x 47cm deep) has large double doors at the front and three removable shelves, which may be moved to accommodate plants of differing heights.

Both the Plant House and the Cold Frame (40cm high x 100cm wide x 60cm deep) have an adjustable lid with locking side-latches, for variable ventilation and easy watering.
